

Old Testament Memory Work Schedule (Grades 1-3)

Below is a list of memory passages for your child to learn and recite. I listed all of the memory work due for that week. The date listed is the day your child needs to have the passages recited by. Your child can recite to me when they are ready. They can recite 1 passage a day, all of them at once, whatever works best for your child. The due date is going to be every Friday. If there is no school on Friday, then it will be due the last day of school that week. Any memory work not recited by the last day of the school week will receive a failing grade. All children learn and recite at different levels. Please do not put off learning memory work until Thursday night. What a great opportunity we have to study God's Word with our children.

Our Memory work schedule for the year is in your child's home folder. When you get to the bottom of the sheet, please pull out the top sheet and flip over to the next side. Continue doing this throughout the school year.
