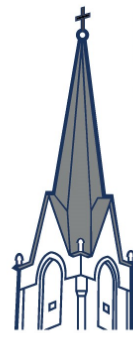

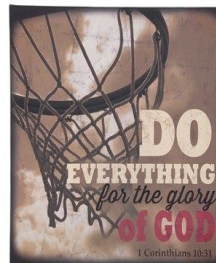

Building Our Future On Christ Campaign UPDATE: One of the goals of the Building our Future on Christ campaign at MLHS is already coming to fruition -- debt reduction. Of the over \$2.1 million currently pledged to the campaign, over \$712,000 has already been received. This has allowed us to use \$220,000 of this money to pay down our debt, saving \$11,000 annually in interest payments! Meanwhile, we continue to work toward the estimated goal of \$9.8 million and continue moving forward with our ministry expansion plans.
