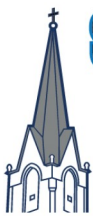

MLC SCHOLARSHIP—This Fall Maya Aden, Josh Aden, Lynsey Marohn and Michaela Bubolz will be attending MLC, and plan on being Called Workers in our Synod. The cost of attending MLC is \$27,900/year, so we have created a scholarship fund to help with the cost in their educations. These students can receive up to \$1,000.00 from their congregation and MLC will match it. Last year we received \$5,100.00 from the offering and as a result, each of our 3 students received \$1,700.00 from SJSJ. This year we need \$4,000.00 so that each of our students can receive a \$1000.00 match. We have \$ 3,155.00 so far. This special offering will end next Sunday, June 28th.
