Next school year the cost of attending MLC will be \$29,350. We have established a Scholarship Fund to help fund their education. MLC Scholarship our goal \$9,000, received \$2,081.50; still needed \$6,918.50.


MLHS Scholarship our goal \$6,900, received \$1,831.50; still needed \$5,068.50.
