MLC/MLHS—This fall Josh Aden, Michaela Bubolz and Hailey Marohn will be attending MLC in New Ulm, MN. They plan on being Called Workers in our Synod. Next school year the cost of attending MLC will be \$29,350. We have established a Scholarship Fund to help fund their education. If the students home congregation gives each student \$1,350, MLC will match it.

We will have 3 students at MLHS who do not receive financial assistance. Tuition at MLHS is \$6,000. We are running this special offering from March 26th to June 4th. If you wish to make a contribution, please mark your envelope, either MLC Scholarship. or MLHS Scholarship. If you wish to contribute to both funds mark your envelope MLC/MLHS Scholarship. 
