

MLC—This year we received \$9,660.00 for our 3 students who will be attending MLC this fall. Each student will receive \$3,220.00. A few weeks ago Josh Aden has accepted a call to be an emergency teacher this coming school year. Therefore, he will not be a student at MLC this year so we don't need any tuition assistance for him. He will be returning to MLC next year to finish his education. The Planned Giving Committee, the Stewardship Committee and Church Council have decided to keep the \$3,220. for Josh in Charities so he will have it next year. Our reasoning is that our members were very generous because we had 3 students attending MLC. Now we have 2 students attending this year. We thank all of our members for supporting this scholarship fund.
