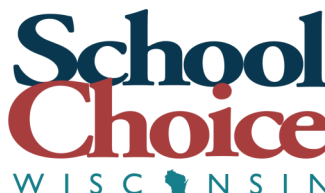
DIVINE CALLS

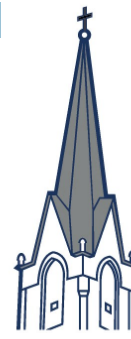
SCHOOL CHOICE
