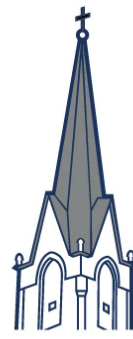

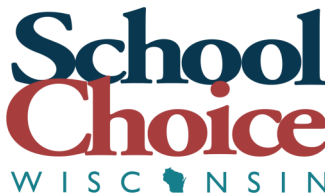
DIVINE CALLS

MUSIC FEST PRACTICE

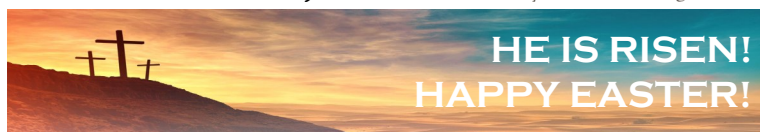
