MLC/MLHS—This fall Josh Aden will be attending MLC in New Ulm, MN. He plans on being Called Worker in our Synod. Next school year the cost of attending MLC will be \$30,095. We have established a Scholarship Fund to help fund his education. If the student's home congregation gives each student \$1,450, MLC will match it.

We will have 7 students at MLHS who would benefit from financial assistance. Tuition at MLHS is \$7400.

We are running this special offering from March ^{31st} to June 2nd.


SCHOOL OFFICE CLOSED—The school office will be closed all day Friday, May 17th.
