- * Pastor Albert Kluge, who founded our school, came to St. John-St. James in 1866.
- In May of 1867 the congregation asked each member to contribute 25 cents to start a school fund for purchasing equipment. {Hence, our quarter war this year}.
- Our Christian Day School was founded in 1874. Our present church was built five years later in 1879.
- In 1875, the 25th anniversary year of our synod, only 85 congregations in the synod had Christian Day schools. St. John-St. James was one of them. Today our synod has 308 Lutheran Elementary Schools and 356 Early Childhood Ministries.
- Our school had about 30 students the first year.
- Classes were held in our first church building which was built in 1859.
- After our present church was built in 1879, the old church became the permanent school.
